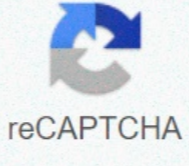

How to reset amazon kindle 4

Amazon's Kindle is a convenient tool for business owners who enjoy reading and are constantly on the go. In addition, the Kindle functions as a tablet PC, which provides busy travelers with a compact way to browse the Web, update their company's social networking profiles and remotely chat with employees and colleagues. However, like any other mobile computing device, the Kindle is susceptible to viruses, malware and other things that can slow down a computer. So if your Kindle has fallen victim to these problems, restore the device to its factory settings. A factory reset (or factory default) is suggested before gifting or selling a device, and in some cases for troubleshooting. Important: A factory reset removes all your personal data and downloaded content, returning the device to its original factory settings. If you use the VoiceView Over Bluetooth feature, you'll need to download the file to your device from: [Download the VoiceView Audio File for Your Device](#). From the home screen, select Menu. Select Settings. Select Menu again then select Reset Device. Upon completion of a factory reset, your device is deregistered from your Amazon account. To use the device, register it again. xSorry to interrupt!CSS Error I think as a Kindle user, all of us will encounter a problem that Kindle won't turn on. In some cases, it's easy to solve. But sometimes, it really takes efforts to figure out what's wrong with the device and how to fix it. Last weekend, when I bought some eBooks from Kindle store and want to read them on my Kindle fire, I pressed the power button, only to discover that it just won't turn on. After a bit of checking around, I discovered some solutions for this common issue. Fortunately, in most of the time, it can be fixed pretty easy. Here are some tricks to try, including extra solutions when these tricks don't work. Kindle locked up, the screen frozen - Reset Kindle Device If your Kindle device won't turn on, for most of the time, this doesn't mean that it's "broken" or has a problem. Most of the electronic devices, including smartphones or tablets, have a tendency to become "stuck", when the device is stuck, the power is on but it will not work properly because it's locked up. To unlock the Kindle device, the easiest and fastest solution is resetting your Kindle device. Press and hold down the power button for 20 seconds or longer. Then turn the device back on by hitting the power button again. If this doesn't work the first time, you can try holding the button down for 30 seconds or longer. Most of the time, this will be all you have to do to make the Kindle Fire work again. Factory Reset the Device If the soft resetting didn't work, and the device continued locking up, you can reboot the device to factory settings to clear out any data or apps. Tap the "Quick Settings" icon and then press "More" > "Device" > "Reset to Factory Defaults". Please keep this in mind that it will delete all the data on your device, although you can download the purchased apps or books later from Amazon Cloud. Charging or battery issues - Recharge the device or replace the battery](#) Another common reason for Kindle does not turn on is the battery running out, the device will not turn on unless you recharge it. Plugging the Kindle device into your computer and wait about 30 minutes before trying to turn it on again. If the device refuses to start up, try resetting it again. If it still won't turn on, it's possible that you have a broken charging cable. The cables that come with the Kindle are not known for their quality. Try charging the tablet with another cord that has a Micro USB connection and see if the device responds. Normally, the charging cord from your smartphones and tablets (Android Device) will work with the Kindle. And there another possibility is that the battery is broken, then you need to replace a new one. Broken device - Fix the broken part by yourself if neither resetting the device nor recharging it solves the problem, the device's hardware may have broken, and you will need to have it repaired or replaced. Tap this option and your Kindle will restart.How to perform a hard restart your Amazon KindleIf Your Kindle stops responding to your touch or button input, or becomes sluggish or otherwise uncooperative, performing a hard restart may restore it to its former glory.To conduct a hard restart, simply press and hold the power button for six to eight seconds. After around 10 seconds have gone by, your Kindle's display should go blank. Don't panic: This is part of the Kindle's restart process.Continue to hold the power button for one minute, then release it. When you release the power button, you'll note that the charge indicator light (the location of this light will vary, depending on which Kindle you own) will turn on. Once this happens, your Kindle will restart, allowing you to start reading, once more. All of your downloaded and side-loaded content will be waiting for you, right where you left it.How to factory-reset your KindleIf your Kindle continues to act wonky after forcing it to restart, it may be beneficial to reset it to its original factory settings. This is also a great way to prepare it before passing it along to a friend as a gift, or if you plan on selling it.You should know that resetting your Kindle will remove all of the downloaded or side-loaded documents you may have had on the device. Additionally, your Wi-Fi settings, Amazon account information, and any passcodes or parental controls you may have applied to the Kindle will be wiped.To perform a factory reset on your Kindle, turn your Kindle on. If you're in the middle of reading a book, return to your device's Home screen. Next, tap the Menu icon (three vertical dots located at the top right of the Home screen,) and select Settings. Halfway down the page, you should see a menu option titled Device Options. Tap this. Near the bottom of the Device Options page is an option labeled Reset. Select the option; doing so will open a dialog that asks you if you're sure that you want to wipe your Kindle of all of its content and settings. If you want to continue, select Yes. Every time I restart/soft reset, it magically returns to a previous state(with a specific set of books and deletes all new books and settings). Even if I manually delete all files or format the device, it restores those files every time I restart it. No one seems to have this problem with a kindle.I also tried installing duokan on my device, but the minute I restart it(step 5), I doesn't go to debug mode, instead restores my files.You might ask why I want to reset it in the first place. It's because all my e-books crash and I get the message that the book is damaged/corrupted; try downloading again. Now it doesn't give this error as soon as I open it, it does when I've read the 30-40% of the book.Also tried opening the back cover, but removing the cover is too damn difficult and I might break the cover.Please suggest some way out of this mess.!!;dr : every book gives error that the book is damaged, tried resetting but certain files keep reappearing out of nowhere.Page 2 5 comments
