"What method should you use for your answer?If you have work experience, both of the options we've discussed are very good, and it really depends on what you feel most comfortable with.Choose what you like. These are both great ways to answer the question, so don't stress it!However, if you're a beginner and don't have work experience or at least an internship, then I'd go back to the beginning of this article and use the first 5-step method to answer, "Tell me about yourself".It's really best if you want to give a single, concise answer and you have some relevant work experience to share during the interview!Practice your response before the interviewAs a last tip, make sure you go practice everything you're going to say when the interviewer asks, "What can you tell me about yourself?"Nothing comes out perfect the first time, and you don't want to appear nervous and stumble when they ask. So I would suggest you take a piece of paper and write down the key points you want to talk about in your answer. I like to write them in bullet format.Then, use your smartphone's voice recorder app to record some practical answers and see how it sounds.Don't look at the notes while you answer. The idea is to try to remember what you want to talk about without reading the paper. Then look at the AFTER sheet to make sure you've covered it all up.Keep practicing until you are able to give a smooth answer without forgetting anything important.Note: If you have an interview you can use notes/points to help you understand your answer. Nobody can see you on the phone, so take advantage of it! Take advantage!
