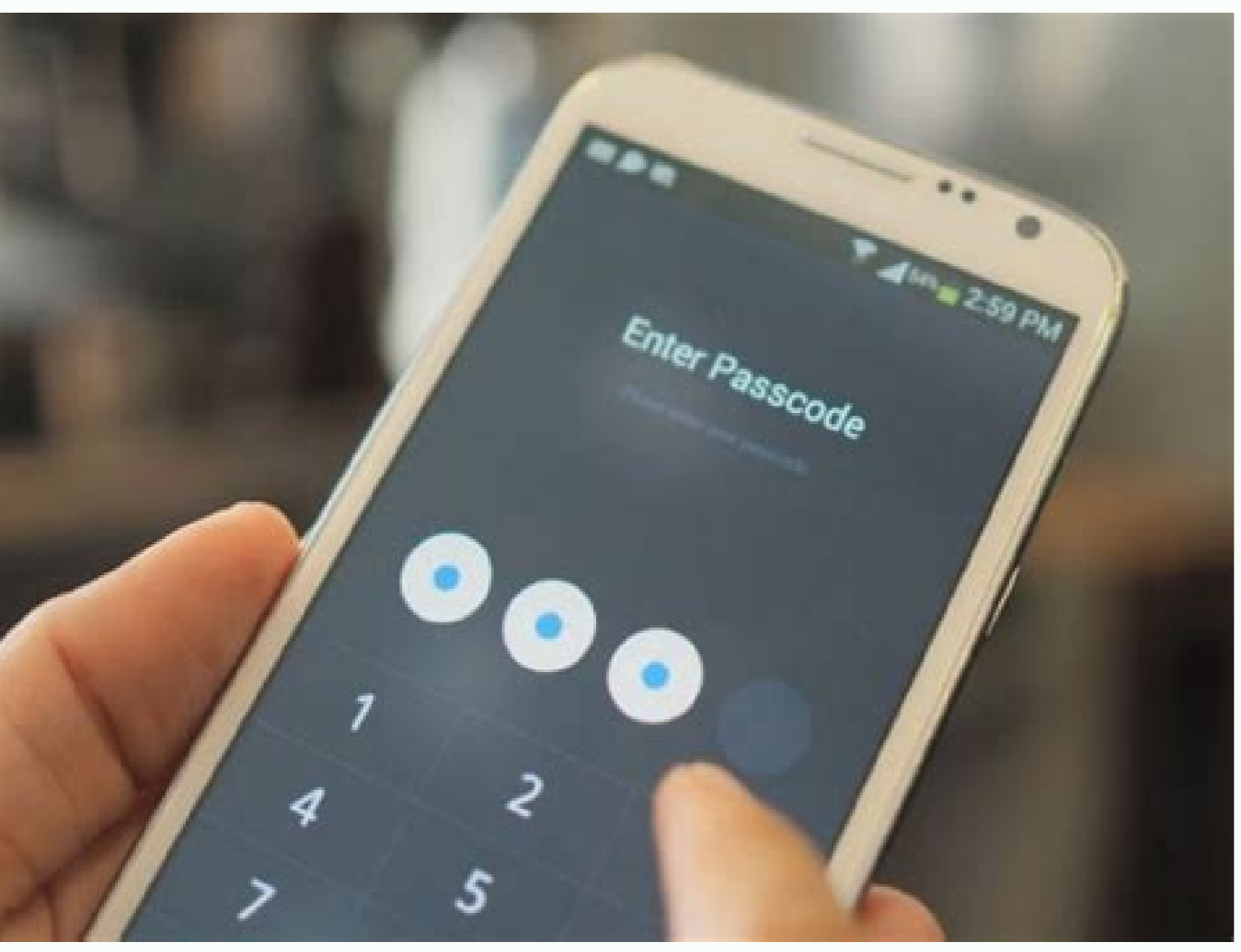
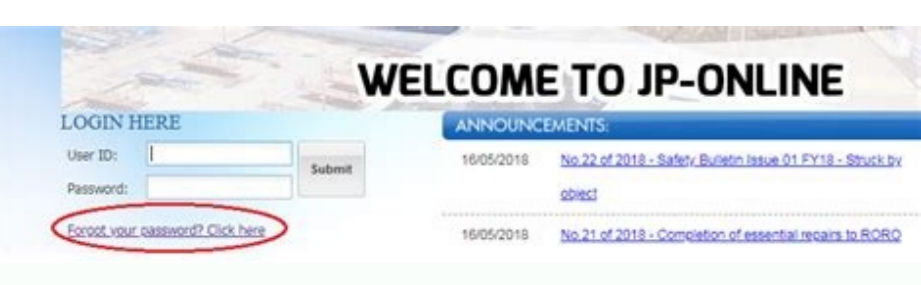

If your password contains different types of characters, make sure you enter the correct password, including the correct letters and symbols such as underscores. If you find that the length or type of your lock screen password has changed, or your screen is locked even though you haven't set a password, there's a good chance that PrivateSpace is on. Try the PrivateSpace password to access your device. If you've forgotten your password, see I forgot my PrivateSpace password. Or restart your phone/tablet. Your phone/tablet will automatically access MainSpace after reboot. If you are logged in with a user account, you cannot use the owner password to unlock the lock screen. Switch back to the owner account and try to unlock again. To switch between accounts, tap on your profile pictures (as shown in the image below) or restart your phone/tablet. Your phone/tablet will automatically access MainSpace after reboot. If you have forgotten your phone/tablet password and want to unlock it, you will need to factory reset your device. However, all data on the phone/tablet will be deleted and cannot be recovered. It's a good idea to check if you've backed up your phone/tablet data to the cloud or some other way. It's also a good idea to check that you or someone else hasn't changed your password. If you still don't remember the password, please follow the steps below to factory reset the device: Turn off the phone/tablet and disconnect the USB cable if it is connected. Press and hold the power and volume up buttons. When the phone/tablet vibrates, hold the buttons for 5 seconds until the phone/tablet enters recovery mode. The operation depends on the device model. You can also try the following: press and hold the power button for about 5 seconds while the device is turned off. When the device vibrates when turned on, press and hold the Volume Up button (without releasing the Power button) for about 2 seconds. The screen will then turn off for about 10 seconds and the device will enter recovery mode. Press the volume up and down button to select wipe data and confirm by pressing the power button. (For products that support a touch screen in recovery mode, you can perform these steps by double-tapping the screen.) Press the volume up and down buttons to factory reset the device and confirm by pressing the power button. For some device models, you will need to confirm again by typing "yes" before performing a factory reset. Follow the instructions on the screen to complete the process. After the factory reset, your device will return to the recovery screen. Click the appropriate button to reboot your device. If the activation screen appears after the device restarts, Find My Device is enabled. Enter your HUAWEI ID password to access the system. If you have forgotten your HUAWEI account password, please visit the password reset page. If your HUAWEI account has been deleted, you will not be able to log into that HUAWEI account and use your phone/tablet with that account again because all your data has been deleted and cannot be recovered. You can remotely unlock your mobile device by accessing the Find My Mobile feature. However, to use this feature, make sure your mobile device meets the following requirements. The mobile device must be turned on. Mobile device must be connected to Wi-Fi or mobile network. Your Samsung account must be registered on your mobile device and the remote unlock option must be enabled. You can set your device to unlock itself and stay unlocked when trusted places or devices are found. For example, if you set your home as a trusted location, when you return home, the device will detect the location and unlock automatically. This feature is available after setting the screen lock method. If you don't use the device for four hours or don't turn it on, the screen must be unlocked using the set pattern, PIN or password.
