The Masoretic Text is a traditional Hebrew text completed by Jewish researchers around 1000 C.E. The Septuagint is a Greek translation of the Torah created by the Jews of Alexandria in the third century B.C.E. (The other books of the Hebrew Bible were translated during the third century.) According to the tradition of Septant, at least 70 former isolated scholars came with identical Greek translations of the Torah.



What's the Bible? How do we decide who these two most important old texts are? In "the search for the "original" in the July/August 2014 edition of Biblical Archaeology Review, scholar of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and editor-in-chief of the publishing team of Dead Sea Scrolls Emanuel Tov suggests that we go to the Dead Sea Scrolls to help us compare the Masoretic Text and the Septuagint.
